If you are interested in participating in our January activity, please turn in the attached commitment form along with your deposit to reserve your spot. This is an awesome activity that gives you the opportunity to learn how to ride in and drive a team of trained sled dogs in the vast terrain of Michigan's Upper Peninsula during the winter.

We have to make our reservations NOW. A group of 12 mushers will keep the costs to a comfortable level. If we have more, it could reduce the overall cost per person.

To take a 4 hour sled trip, rent some snowshoes for a separate hike, cabin use, fuel and food will cost each participant \$255.00 each. To go without dog sledding will cost \$110.00.

Itinerary to include 2 days to travel over 800 miles. The 2nd day ½ the group will snowshoe hike on Bruno's Run, while the other takes dogsleds. The 3rd day we switch groups. All meals will be prepared troop style and sleeping arrangements are split between 2 cabins, keeping scouts separate from adults.
